



Dear Parents / Carers,

During the Summer term we cover Relationships and Changing Me with the children as part of their Personal, Social, Health Education (PSHE) – this includes Sex and Relationships Education. From September 2020, the Government have issued new guidelines making Relationship, Health and Sex Education (RHSE) compulsory in primary schools. This means that as parents and carers, you will not have the right to withdraw your child from this subject. We are planning to teach the missed units of work as soon as pupils return to school.

Understandably, you may have some thoughts on this. Each year we usually invite you to come into school and look at the resources and talk to us about any worries, concerns or questions you might have. Obviously that will not be possible at this time.
