Drop off and pick up times	Stagger the start and end times to reduce the number of people on site Mark the floor to show where to safely wait Create clear waiting spaces for each group Provide a one way system onto the main playground	Stay with my adult while waiting to come into school and be collected	Ensure I bring and collect my child on time Ensure only one adult brings and collects my child Ensure I wait with my child at the designated place, observing social distancing Follow the one way system in and out of school
Break times and lunch times	Stagger break times to reduce the number of groups out at one time Create safe spaces for each group to play in away from other groups	Stay in my designated play space Tell an adult if I need the toilet Play games that do not involve touching others	Remind my child of the need to play games that do involve touching others
Adults	Ensure the same adult is with the group in the classroom all day and wherever possible all week (for the groups returning to school)	Listen to the adult who is with my group and stay with my groups	Help my child identify their adult each day
Contacting staff	Communicate any issues via phone or the year group email	Ensure I tell adults of any issues during the day	Call or email school with any concerns that I may have. Be polite and courteous to staff at all times understanding that staff are working at all times to minimise risks.
Office area	Be available by phone or email to answer queries		Contact the office by phone or email If there is an emergency observe social distancing in the school foyer Understand that if a face to face meeting is needed social distancing will be followed
Cleanliness	Ensure that we have soap and hand sanitiser readily available and that regular handwashing is insisted upon. Provide children with all the equipment that they need in a personalised pack so that they do not need to share. Provide a healthy lunch for all children. Make sure that environments are kept clean. Provide drinking water for children throughout the day	Not bring anything to school including my mobile phone Wash my hands when I am told to. Sneeze and cough into a tissue and put the tissue into the bin straight away. Eat my meals sitting in my place. Use my tray to keep my pack and jumper in. Try to keep some safe space between me and my friends. Use my new equipment and look after it.	Make sure that my children are kept clean with a daily change of clean clothing. Make sure my child washes their hands before leaving the house Access the school meals for the days that my child is in school. Make sure that no personal belongings, including phones, are brought to school.
Social distancing and safe behaviours	Insist on maintaining distance, as much as we are able, and maintain high levels of hygiene for all members of the Academy community and the environment.	Be respectful to people all the time. Keep my friends safe by not hugging them or touching them. Walk home alone or with my adult collecting me	Talk to my child about the need for high levels of hygiene. This includes not hugging, holding hands, sharing their drinks/food, spitting etc as well as washing hands thoroughly when asked to and when they wish to. Ensure my child follows social distancing when not in the academy
Well being	Provide care and nurture for your child as we always have done	Follow the new rules in school to keep everybody safe.	Support us as we endeavour to get the children back to school.
Key worker groups	Ensure the groups are no bigger than 15 Ensure all children have access to the home learning and other activities	Stay with my group and listen to the adult leading my group	Continue to inform the academy of the days I need to care for my child
Illness and symptoms	Inform the parents of the group of children should one of them display symptoms and advise on self-isolation for 14 days and testing. This includes the adult displaying symptoms. Call parents to collect individual children should they be ill in any other way. Keep any child displaying symptoms safely away from others in a designated room and care for them using PPE	Tell an adult straight away if I feel unwell in any way.	Keep my child off school if they display symptoms or if they are ill. Call school to let them know that my child will not be in and why as soon as possible. Make sure the school has at least 2 contact numbers and someone can be contacted throughout the day
