Dear Parents/Carers,

We have been taking on feedback from parents and have looked at ways we can support. We understand that some of the issues you are facing include trying to teach multiple children in different year groups, trying to share devices, trying to see the work on a phone and trying to work at home while teaching your child/ren. We completely understand the dilemmas that lots of you have facing and have put together some alternatives to support.

We will continue to post work up daily on the website and if you can access these then they should be the first choice as they cover work we have done and use explanations that the children are familiar with.

However there are alternatives that may support. Each week each year groups will pick out Education City activities that support the learning. This should help where you are trying to work from home or support other children as the children can follow these activities independently

Also, the BBC are producing daily lessons. These can be accessed online, or on the TV. They show primary lessons on TV at 9am and these can also be accessed on the red button. Again these can help where you are trying to support multiple children or share devices or work from home.

It is perfectly acceptable to replace any of the learning with these alternatives or indeed an activity from one of the websites on the Home Learning page. Please do communicate with your teacher if you have done this so they know what everyone is accessing and can support with the learning.

Please be reassured we are asking for contact via email so we can support with the learning and to ensure that everyone is safe and well so remember to email each week. Hopefully a reply from your teacher will give your child the encouragement to keep on learning!

If you are still finding it difficult completing or accessing work please email and let your teacher know so we can find another way to support.

When I have spoken to parents I have been so impressed with the dedication you are giving to your children's learning. As previously said this work is revision and missing some of the work will not set your child back at all. Keep doing all that you can but please do not let this situation bring stress to you or your family at what is already a strange and stressful time. I hope you have picked up on the fact that we hugely support reading so keep this up!
