Dear Parent/Carer,

As I am sure you are aware we have been instructed by the government to close the school to all pupils except those who have parents who are critical workers or pupils who are deemed vulnerable. Therefore the majority of children will not be in school tomorrow, Tuesday 5th January.

If you are a critical worker <u>and there is no one at home to look after your child</u> then please contact the office via the office email or by calling at 8am in the morning. <u>Please do not send your child to school unless you have spoken to us or received a confirmation email</u>. Critical workers are those whose work is deemed essential to carry on as part of the fight against Covid-19. When you request your place please let us know your job role so we can check it fits the critical worker criteria.

If you believe your child is entitled to a place due to being in the vulnerable category (they have an EHCP or allocated social worker) please also contact the office email or call at 8am to confirm you are taking the place. Please do not send your child to school unless you have spoken to us or received a confirmation email.

For those children accessing work remotely please start with utilising our online learning opportunities such as Lexia, Education City and Times Tables Rockstars and we will post work up on the website under the home learning tab. There will be work up tomorrow by lunchtime and for subsequent days we will ensure the work is posted daily by 9am.

Once we have set up our provision in school and remotely I will be in contact with more information regarding how the home learning will work going forward. Please keep an eye on your emails and our Facebook page for information.
