

During the partial reopening of schools due to Covid-19 the following addendum has been made to the Behaviour Policy.

Our school rules will still apply to all children when they are on site or walking to and from school

To show respect for each other

To respect all property and resources.

To always do your best in your learning.

To take responsibility for your actions

These rules take into account the need for social distancing and we will ensure that all pupils are taught, in an age appropriate way, the importance of social distancing at this time.

Failure to follow the social distancing rules which include, but are not exclusive, to keeping apart from other children, remaining in their seat, only playing with children in their group, washing hands when required, will mean the academy will apply their sanctions as set out in the behaviour guide.

'Any pupil who commits serious or persistent breach of the new COVID-19 protection rules may be sanctioned by the Principal using the full range of sanctions available, dependent on the seriousness of the breach, up to and including in extreme cases permanent exclusion.'

Incidents that put others at risk will be dealt with in line with our behaviour guide. Deliberate acts will be dealt with as higher level behaviours. These may result in a fixed term exclusion. Acts that are not deemed deliberate will be dealt with as lower level behaviours and staff will follow the behaviour guide for these. Repeated offences will be dealt with as higher level behaviours. The sanctions for low level behaviours have been adapted to ensure that groups do not mix. For step 3 all come out will be taken in the same room. Step 4 will be removed and pupils who continue to not follow the rules will be sent straight to a member of SLT.
