World Book Day

World Book Day takes place on Thursday 3rd March. We are inviting children to dress up as a book character. This is always a fun experience and we love seeing the imaginative costumes and guessing

each character. We would love everyone to take part but please do be creative and don't feel you need to purchase anything new – many books have children as characters that you could come as. Each child will be receiving a **£1 book voucher** after half term, which can be exchanged for a free World Book Day book or can be put towards the purchase of another book.
