Appointments will be online and we are using a new online booking and video-conferencing system. You will be sent home a sheet with a unique login code and instructions of what to do. That code is unique to you and your child so please keep it safe. Once you have registered, you will be able to book an appointment with your child's class teacher. We will not be using Teams or Zoom as the new system, **SchoolCloud** includes video calling within it.

Please make sure that you book the correct appointment. SEND appointments are 30 minutes long and take place the week beginning 21st March. Other appointments are 10 minutes and take place the week beginning 28th March.
