Charity and fundraising events

Buddies

All of the children involved acted with huge maturity; the school council as they considered each response and the candidates as they went through the recruitment process. Drop off/collection

Well done to all the children who continue to arrive on time for school. As you know our car park gets very congested and there is limited parking. We are working with our estates team to look at ways to improve this. However, the best thing is to park away from the school site and walk the last bit in. We are not able to provide staff to supervise the car park or road into school, please ensure you continue to be careful and courteous as you drive onto and off the site.

Please can I remind all parents that dogs, and other pets, must not be brought onto site. It has also been reported that parents are smoking near the gates by the tennis court while waiting for them to open in the morning. While we appreciate this is not directly on school property, we are asking for there not to be smoking near to where children are waiting for school.

Absence and attendance

Our attendance is currently 94.9% for the whole school which is lower than previous years. There is definitely an impact from Covid absences which we appreciate will happen. However, please remember that children should not take time off in term time for holidays unless there are exceptional circumstances. If your child is not in school you must contact the school office in the morning. Please do not use the year group email or Class Dojo for absence messages as there is no guarantee these will be read before school starts.

Jubilee Day 2022

The DfE have reduced the minimum number of sessions for the academic year 2021/2022 to enable all staff working in schools and settings to enjoy an additional bank holiday in term time, to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, as the bank holiday takes place in the May half term holiday. We have decided to end the summer term a day early for this. Therefore school will now finish on Wednesday 20th July 2022.

Even though it is only November we have started planning our Christmas events. Reception and KS1 have started rehearsing their Christmas nativity and singing performance. We are really hoping we can perform these to a live audience but it is too early to make that decision. Any performances will take place in the last 2 weeks of term and we will get details of these to you as soon as we know what is possible.
