

Summer term in Year



Welcome back! We are so excited for our final term in Year 1. We have lots of lovely things planned for the summer.

English

In English, we will continue focusing on using the correct punctuation when writing sentences. We will spend some time looking at writing for different purposes including writing a poem to perform. Our first text this term is 'Farmer Duck' which the children have been loving so far!

Maths

In maths we are starting to learn about multiplication and division by focusing on grouping amounts. We have started learning 'rolling numbers' songs which the children are enjoying to help them chant the multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

Topic

Our main topic this term is called 'School Days. In this topic, we will learn about the Victorian Era including learning about Victorian schools and Victorian artefacts.

In DT we will be making a moving vehicle using axles and wheels. We will also learn about healthy eating and the children will be making a fruit/salad bug. Later in the term we will be learning about plants and animals in our science topic including: grouping, classifying and labelling key parts.

PE

Our PE days are as follows:
