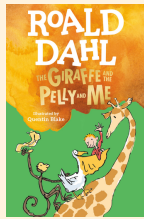


English

by Roald Dahl

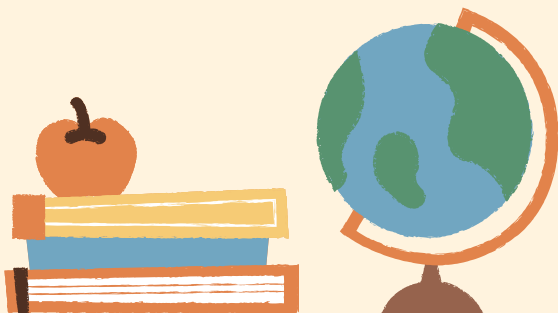


Meerkat Mail
